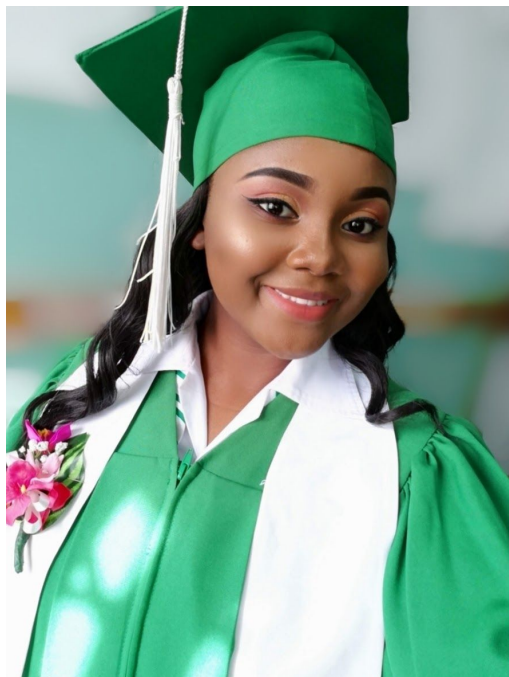


Biosketch
